b) Discussion of Policy Regarding Non-Discrimination in Employment in First Reading-

- -Motion by Trowbridge to authorize the School District to exceed the Revenue Limit on a non-recurring basis by an amount the district will spend on debt service for energy efficiency measures and energy efficiency products for the 2016-17 school year through the 2028-29 school year. Seconded by Jarvis. Motion carried 4-0 voice vote.

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b) Consideration/Discussion of Upcoming Election for School Board -

- -Motion by Jarvis to approve placing the April 5, 2016 election notice in next week's newspaper. Seconded by Trowbridge. Motion carried 4-0 voice vote.
- c) **Records Retention** Discussed switching the School's email platform from Outlook to Google which archives all emails for free.
