

NEW AUBURN FFA ALUMNI CELEBRATION EVENT

New Auburn High School FFA Alumni recently sponsored a celebration event at The Frog and the Fly east of New Auburn. Those in attendance enjoyed a delicious meal and then proceeded to hear presentations from New Auburn FFA members who have participated in various activities and those who had attended the 89th National FFA Convention in Indianapolis, Indiana Mason Kollwitz commented on his opportunity in attending The World Food Prize's Global Youth Institute in Des Moines, Iowa and how impressive the experience was. Mason is a senior and will be attending the University of Wisconsin-River Falls. Domonic Johnson, freshman FFA member, provided an overview of his experience at the convention. During his presentation Domonic shared a comment from one of the convention speakers stating, "Don't be disappointed when all of your work seems to be for nothing, be positive and happy with the fact that everything you did made you not only better as an individual but also smarter. Domonic also commented on how much he enjoyed meeting new people and participating in the various tours.

Dalton Lauterbach, freshman FFA member, shared his first impressions of attending the 2016 National FFA Convention. Dalton commented that attending the convention was "one of the best experiences

I have had in my lifetime." He also expressed appreciation to the New Auburn FFA Alumni for supporting the New Au-

burn FFA Chapter.

Tina Gordon, FFA member and currently a junior in high school, provided a presentation reflective of her experience at the 2016 National FFA Convention. Tina shared points made by the retiring address of Nick Baker who served as the 2015-16 National Secretary from Tennessee. Nick is originally from Cookeville, Tennessee and upon graduation from college plans to serve in the United States military and eventually work with agriculture policy centered on food security, ina pointed out some of Nick's key points

Mikayla Boehm, eighth grade student, was awarded the Section I State Junior High FFA Essay plaque. She was recognized as one of the top ten essays in the state for her essay centered on the FFA theme, Amplify.

and being ourselves is being authentic.

Zachary Fedie presented the National FFA Agriscience Fair project, on behalf of his team which included Peyton Trowbridge, on

"Engineering a Robot for Cultivation in a Row Crop." Hazel Cody and Violet Hyke presented their National FFA Agriscience Fair project titled, "Melted Snow Quality — Within Their Environment". McKenzie Frank provided a presentation on her agriscience project, "Green Roofs & Stormwater Mitigation." All three competing projects earned a rating of national silver. Domonic Johnson's project titled, Analyzing Plastic Wrap to Lessen Food Spillage, earned a national bronze rating after the required national pre-screen reviews.

Mikayla Boehm was named sectional winner at the state level in the Junior High FFA Essay contest. She was presented with an award plaque for this achievement. Mikayla had written an essay centered on the National FFA

theme titled Amplify.

During the evening's celebration, Cody Simmons commented on the New Auburn FFA Chapter being recognized for being awarded a Local Program Success Grant for their program: "New Auburn FFA Heartwalk — 10th Anniver-

sary." Cody Simmons and Tina Gordon accepted this recognition, on behalf of the chapter, during the National FFA Alumni Association's national session.

Cody Simmons, who also serves as president of the New Auburn FFA Chapter, highlighted the 2017 New Auburn FFA Heartwalk. Scheduled date for the heartwalk is July 22nd, 2017 which will be held at the New Auburn Park Pavilion. Cody designed this year's 2017 New Auburn FFA Heartwalk Tee-Shirts with the theme, Making a World of Difference...One Beat at a Time." It is the chapter's goal to have "One Hundred at the Heart" celebrating the ten years that the New Auburn FFA Chapter has been holding their heartwalk. Cody is currently a senior at New Auburn High School and is planning on attending Northland College in
