2016 Statewide Transition Academy

"Transition Practices" was the subject of a presentation by New Auburn High School teachers and students at the 2016 Statewide Transition Academy held October 4-5 in Wisconsin Dells. Kristine North, Special Needs teacher, and Cindy Sheskey, Business & Information Technology teacher, along with students Helen Glaser and Nicole Nimsger highlighted best practices from their Career Skills Class. This inclusive class, which is co-taught by Mrs. North and Ms. Sheskey, has a mixture of students with and without special needs working together. helping students develop employability skills the class operates two schoolbased businesses: a Snack Cart and Bal-Loons and Buttons.

During their presentation, the students took the audience on a virtual tour of the businesses highlighting specific tasks required in operating each business. Those tasks include inventory control; communications with customers; product deliveries; cash control, customer service and marketing. Two highlights of the course are the Business and Community Outreach Day and *Mock Interviews*. The Outreach Day enables students to visit a variety of area businesses to learn what employers expect of good employees, how the business advertises for employees, and what the business does. The students shared the benefits of preparing a resume' and cover letter and practicing their interview skills with people from the business community during the mock interviews.

Mrs. North and Ms. Sheskey discussed the rigorous curriculum of the Career Skills class which includes business ethics, communications skills

in the workplace, self-advocacy, career exploration, planning for post-secondary education and work after high school, conducting a job search, and employment compensation and laws. The teachers explained how students and employers can benefit from this type of course offering.

Four hundred students, parents, teachers and other school officials attended this year's transition academy, the theme of which was "College and Career Ready."
