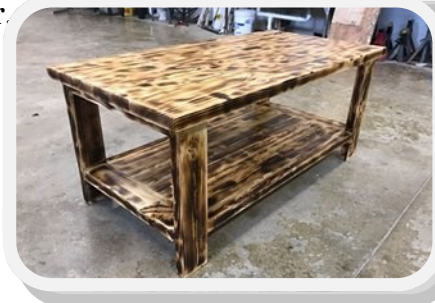

# New Auburn Careers Class

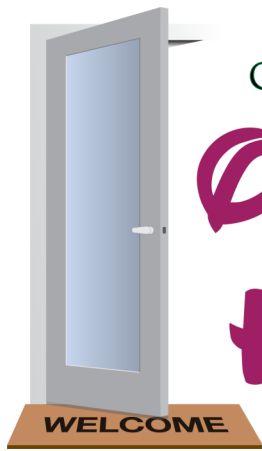

## Kindergarten Open House

On Thursday, March 14th and Friday, March 15th, the School District of New Auburn will be holding a Kindergarten Open House for those children who will be 5 years old by September 1, 2019. The morning Open House session will run from 9:00-11:30 and the afternoon session will run from 1:00-3:00. Your family will be assigned to a screening time on one of those days.

The staff has created a less formal setting to create a more relaxed and enjoyable experience for your child. When your child visits he/she will have the opportunity to see the Kindergarten classroom, meet the Kindergarten teachers, and take part in some centers that involve fine motor, art, and problem solving and social skills.

During the Open House, parents will have a chance to meet the Kindergarten teachers and ask any questions that you may have about the Kindergarten program.

Parents will be filling out all the necessary paperwork on this day. The Open House will take place in Mrs. Bergh's Kindergarten classroom.

***This year's Kindergarten classes will not have school on the Open House days.***

## 4K Registration

On Thursday, March 14th and Friday, March 15th, the School District of New Auburn will be holding a 4K registration for those children who will be 4 years old by September 1, 2019. The morning Open House session will run from 9:00-11:30 and the afternoon session will run from 1:00-3:00. Your family will be assigned to a screening time on one of those days. During this time, your child will have an opportunity to see the 4K classroom, meet the teachers, participate in activities in the classroom, partake in a speech and language screening, and have their hearing checked.

During the Registration, parents will have a chance to meet the 4K teacher and ask any questions that you may have about the program.

Parents will be filling out all the necessary paperwork on this day. The Registration will take place in Miss J's 4K classroom.

If you do not receive information in the mail about these registration days by the middle of February, please call Bonnie Halberg at 237-2202 ext 102 to be sure you are on the census and information will be sent to you.
