

# Student Dress Code

(New Auburn School) Revised August 2010

**Student Dress Code:** The following is a summary of the dress code as it is stated in the Student Handbook *Students are reminded that we have a dress code in New Auburn that encourages students to take pride in their appearance. For that reason, we tell you that students may not wear clothing that is too revealing, advertises tobacco products, alcohol, drugs, sexually explicit, or inappropriate messages. Students wearing inappropriate clothing will be asked to change into something appropriate immediately. Student and parent cooperation in this area is appreciated.*

- Absolutely no bare midriffs. (This includes while walking in the halls or sitting in class.)
- No low-cut shirts, blouses, or tops.
- Shoulders should be covered and must have a minimum of a 4" strap on tops.
- Clothing must cover the student's underwear or boxers.
- The old fashion "undershirt" or "tank top" may not be worn unless covered by an appropriate shirt.
- No head covers, caps, hats, headbands, bandannas, etc.
- (Grades 7-12) Shorts should have a minimum of a 5" inseam.
- (Grades PreK-6) Shorts should be an appropriate length.
- (Grades PreK-12) Skirts and dresses must extend/cover 75% of the length from the hip bone down to the knee cap at all times.
- All students must have the body parts covered that are meant to be covered!

Please remember that clothing may not be too revealing. Education is a priority in the New Auburn School and inappropriate clothing is a distraction to learning.

The dress code applies to all school activities before, during, and after school. (Examples: Sporting events, Prom, Dances, etc.) An exception may be granted for athletes participating on a school team wearing a school uniform. (Examples: Basketball jerseys, baseball or softball hats)
